Regular Membership: \$75.00 per year. All persons who are enrolled members of any Indian tribe or band, or persons who are recognized by their Indian community of residence or origin as being Indian, Alaska Native or Native Hawaiian, and who have graduated from a school of law or have been admitted to any other bar association. Regular members shall pay dues, and shall be eligible to vote and hold office in the NNABA, and shall have all other rights, privileges, and duties attendant to NNABA membership.

Associate Membership: \$75.00 per year. All persons who are enrolled members of any Indian tribe or band, or persons who are recognized by their Indian community of residence or origin as being Indian, Alaska Native or Native Hawaiian, who have regular assignments or duties as advocates, prosecutors, or judicial officers in tribal courts. Associate members shall pay dues, shall neither vote nor hold office in the NNABA, but shall have all other rights, privileges, and duties attendant to a NNABA membership.

Special Membership: \$75.00 per year. All persons who not eligible for regular or associate membership. Special members shall pay dues, shall neither vote nor hold office in the NNABA, but shall have all other rights, privileges and duties attendant to a NNABA membership.
