We ask that the Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources also support this historic nomination at the upcoming Senate confirmation hearing.

An enrolled citizen of the Laguna Pueblo, Rep. Haaland would become the first Indigenous person to hold a Cabinet position. Rep. Haaland is uniquely qualified to assume this position. Since being elected to Congress in 2018 and re-elected in 2020, Rep. Haaland has demonstrated solid leadership and the ability to build meaningful relationships with members of the House and Senate on tough issues.
