EBSC provides legal services, community organizing, and transformative education to refugees and asylum seekers. Our attorneys provide free and low-cost legal services for people escaping all forms of violence and persecution. To date, we have helped over 4,000 people achieve asylum with a 97.6 percent success rate. We also offer other legal services such as residency, family petitions, [Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals \(DACA\)](#), Temporary Protected Status (TPS), Special Immigrant Juvenile Status, and naturalization. EBSC works with the most marginalized populations fleeing violence and persecution, including unaccompanied minors; torture victims; survivors of gender-based violence, and individuals from the LGBT community.
