- A minimum of two years post-J.D. experience as a practicing attorney conducting legal research, providing legal analysis and recommendations, and preparing legal documents;
 - At least one year of that experience should be in the specialty area of appellate litigation performing legal research and analysis, providing legal advice, and preparing a variety of legal documents; and
- Superior skills in writing, oral advocacy, and research.

Preferred experience:

- Prior federal judicial clerkships; substantial appellate work; critical motions writing; an understanding of the federal securities laws and the Administrative Procedure Act.
