Join us! The Social Security Administration's Office of the General Counsel (OGC) is hiring experienced Labor & Employment Attorneys **throughout the U.S.** for its Office of General Law (OGL).

**WHY SSA:** Social Security touches the lives of millions, providing vital services and a social safety net for the American public. SSA's OGC is a modern public service law office with a highly skilled, engaged, and diverse workforce. We strategically manage a large national workload through effective collaboration and coordination in all aspects of employment law and labor law. We offer the opportunity to handle meaningful and challenging legal work, while earning a competitive salary (plus locality pay), a flexible work schedule, and telework. **Employees may be eligible to work remotely from home.** 

**WHY OGL:** OGL attorneys provide legal guidance on a wide variety of employment related issues including all federal workplace mandates, EEO legal issues, labor law, employee performance management, and employee misconduct. OGL attorneys regularly represent the agency before multiple tribunals including arbitrators, the Equal Employment Opportunity Commission, the Merit Systems Protection Board, and the Federal Labor Relations Authority, as well as coordinate with the Department of Justice in representing SSA in federal district and appellate courts. We seek candidates with strong legal acumen in employment/labor law, litigation experience, research and writing skills, proficiency with eDiscovery, and the ability to quickly form positive relationships with internal clients and partners.

Attorneys joining OGL as an experienced attorney should have at least two years of employment law or labor law experience and ideally will have experience in all phases of litigation. OGL experienced attorneys will have significant responsibility in their workloads, but will receive support, mentorship, and training within OGL's collegial culture.
